



### **HUD's Office of Lead Hazard Control and Healthy Homes**

- ✓ identify and control lead paint hazards in eligible housing
- ✓ Each dollar invested in lead hazard control returns at least \$17
- when in the house addressing lead remediate other hazards such as mold, pests, and radon, that can cause asthma, cancer & other disease

### 501(c)(3) Public charities can lobby

- A charity's lobbying must be an "insubstantial" part of its overall activities
- Most tax practitioners generally advise that charities can safely devote 3-5% of their overall activities toward lobbying


